Willard Community Center Board of Directors Meeting Minutes from June 26, 2019

Members in attendance: Carolyn Kortmeyer, Justin Pflanz, Brett Richert, Will Toliver, and Michelle Lueders via telephone.

Others in attendance: Renee Hein and Janelle Soderling

Mr. Pflanz called the meeting to order at 12:06 pm. Meeting was held at Lincoln Industries.

Mr. Pflanz called for a motion to accept the consent agenda. Mr. Richert made the motion to accept and Ms. Kortmeyer seconded. Motion carried.

Ms. Soderling gave an update that St. Monica's is looking to use space at Willard for programming in the near future. She inquired if we should charge them a rental fee. It was decided that if it didn't cost us anything we didn't need any rent for now but the services must be viewed as a benefit to the community.

Discussion was held about our financial situation. The budget shows we have lost \$46,000. Through April we had lost \$26,000. Ms. Hein commented that the budget is based on a total year. We always struggle during the summer months. We tend to make our money during the school year which helps to cover the summer expenses. We did just receive \$1056.00 for our Step Up to Quality reimbursement.

Mr. Pflanz discussed the election of officers. The current officers have agreed to stay on for another year. Mr. Pflanz presented the slate as: Chair – Ms. Kassy Knudson, Vice-Chair – Mr. Justin Pflanz, Secretary – Ms. Michelle Lueders, and Treasurer – Mr. Joey Mumaugh. Mr. Pflanz stated that we did not have a quorum to make the vote so he will send out an email to everyone to vote via email.

Mr. Pflanz addressed the fund raising efforts this year. The capital campaign really took a toll on the Center. It has been a year and we haven't seen an upturn in the budget as of yet. We are paying \$20,000 annually in interest and this is not covered by the Capital Campaign. Mr. Pflanz suggested again that we may need to try to hire a full time fund raiser/grant writer to focus all efforts on bringing revenue into the Center. The fund raising committee needs more members to commit more time and energy into fund raising. He stated that we will have three pillars of fund raising; Events, Grants, and Donations. Ms. Kortmeyer said that she would step up and help where ever she could. A newsletter is in the works to send out to capital campaign donors to see if they are interested in donating again.

Ms. Soderling gave an update on Give to Lincoln Day. We received \$4,315 in online gifts, \$21,260.29 in offline gifts and the match was \$1,430.54. The total is \$27,005.83. Of this money \$20,500 is designated for the capital campaign and some is for the Poker Run registration but all of this helps us to get more of the match fund. It was determined that we needed to do more promotion for this next year.

Mr. Pflanz gave updates on the Poker Run to be held on July 20<sup>th</sup>. So far we have \$1,000 in sponsorships. We just need to finalize the route and collect raffle prizes. We can still accept sponsorships. Mr. Pflanz told us that his wife, Cassidy, is going to make a flyer to post about the event on Facebook, etc. We need two volunteers at each stop. Mr. Richert and his wife will help with registrations. Everyone is asked to meet at Lincoln Industries the morning of the 20<sup>th</sup> at 10:30 am so that you can pick up materials for the stops and receive any other updates or information.

Mr. Plfanz said that another potential fund raiser this year will be a Karma Ride sponsored by his wife, Cassidy, at Power Cycle. Willard will promote it. People will come and work out and the money paid in will go to Willard.

We are trying something new this year for the golf tournament. Golf Status will be used so that golfers can register on their website, buy sponsorships, and if anyone purchases a technology sponsorship their business logo will be on the app the whole day of the tournament. Mr. Pflanz is excited about the sponsorship opportunities. A sponsor could also agree to pay for a Title XX child for a month or make a van payment one month.

We have met Step 2 of the Step Up to Quality requirements so we were allowed to submit a letter of intent for Lincoln Littles funding. If approved a grant application will follow.

Ms. Soderling reported that she had talked to Ms. Williams and she will be submitting a \$5,000 emergency grant to Lincoln Community Foundation to help with our deficit. She is also hoping to submit a grant to Community Health Endowment to request help with the van expense.

Meeting was adjourned at 1:03 pm.

# Director's Report for June 26, 2019

- 1. We received the Lancaster County Assessment for our building. In 2018 it was valued at \$247,900 and in 2019 is it valued at \$845,600.
- 2. We sold the 1998 Ford 15 passenger van for \$750.00. It was sold to a band called Rewind that is planning on taking it to Phoenix and Los Angeles this summer. They knew the A/C didn't work. I wish them luck.
- 3. Give to Lincoln Day was very successful for Lincoln and the Willard Community Center. We received \$4,315 in online gifts, \$21,260.29 in offline gifts and the match was \$1,430.54. The total is \$27,005.83. Of this money \$20,500 is designated for the capital campaign and some is for the Poker Run registration but all of this helps us to get more of the match fund. Way to go Everyone!
- 4. Representatives from Aging Partners came out to Willard and discussed having a Senior Center here at Willard again. This would be great! They would have their own staff and activities, serve meals every day and provide educational programs. The US Census has shown that we have a high population of senior citizens in our area so this could be a popular program. They would be in the building M-F from 9:00 am to 1:00 pm. I would love to have a senior program here again. I am hoping that they move forward with this. It will be a challenge in the summer and on non-school days with the child care programs but hopefully the advantage of having more people in the building every day will out-weigh any inconveniences. There will be a rental fee for the use of our space too. The amount hasn't been discussed.
- 5. I have been having discussions with St. Monica's. They are interested in bringing the following services to Willard; Out Patient Mental Health and Substance Abuse, Outpatient groups, Circle of Security Parenting Group, and perhaps some other parenting groups. They are not able to provide any rental fee but if all goes well they might be able to in the future. I am not sure what time of day these services would be provided but I will find out. I am hoping they would be in the evenings.
- 6. Community gardens has also been contacted to see if they would like to have a garden spot behind Willard. They currently don't have any gardens in this area. I am hoping to visit with them more about this over the summer. It would be great if the garden could be ready for planting in the spring.
- 7. We have already had some parent concerns about the parking lot and how crowded it is with the construction. Hampton Construction has put a chain link fence around Mourning Hope's property which includes their parking spaces on the south side of the lot. They are going to use that area for staging their construction materials. It is a challenge at 5:00 pm with parent pick up and our three vans on the north side in our spaces.

8. United Way Day of Action was held on Friday, June 21st. A group of 15 volunteers from Black Hills Energy came and read books, donated by United Way, to all the children in our summer program from 8 -9 am. It was a rainy morning so having the volunteers come and spend time with the kids to read a good book was a perfect activity. Every child got to take a book home to add to their libraries. Thank you to United Way and Black Hills Energy for helping to encourage the children to read over the summer.
